Gleason moved to adopt the Ordinance #1105-26 – Uniform Public Offense Code. Raines seconded. The motion carried 5-0.

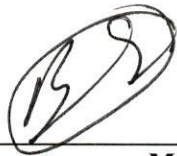
- d) CMB license for El Parralito
